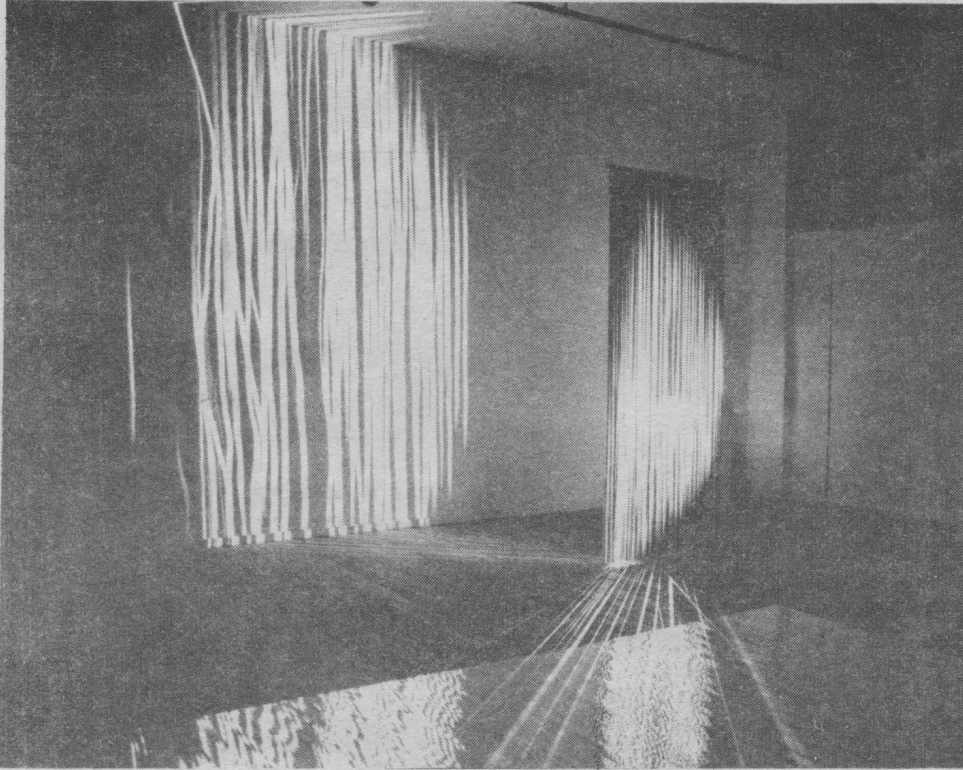


Light on Light

Light on Light, an exhibition of unusual uses of light, will open on Tuesday, February 28, 1984. The opening reception, Saturday, March 3, 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., will be highlighted with a new work — a light performance.

Five Boston area artists, whose works employ actual light, were selected by the jurors: Susan Forest; Nancy Miller, curator of the Rose Art Museum; and Arthur Dion, director of Gallery NAGA. The exhibition includes installations, two-dimensional work, as well as two performances.

Performance artists Beth Galston and Phil Macalary will present new works at the opening reception on Saturday, March 3, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., and on Wednesday, March 14, from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. Other artists represented in the exhibition are: Barbara Abrams, Jeff De Castro, and Miroslav Antic.
